Ten days ago, I underwent cochlearimplant surgery for my right ear in Wuerzburg and in these first few days of recovery I am struggling with fatigue. That is normal, it takes time to get over the effects of the anesthesia, and weariness is part of the normal healing process.

My operation went very well. I felt God's presence throughout the entire time. Many of you were praying for me and the doctors. Thank you so much!

Now, my ear has to heal and then, at the end of July, the doctor will turn on the hearing device. I'm wondering what it will be like. In any case, I will likely be needing months of hearing training.

We are planning our schedule to visit and preach at our partnering churches and many friends in the next months, as well as some conferences we will be attending. Travelling is always exciting, but also strenuous. Thank you all, that you stand by our side and are praying for us.

I am reminded of what Jesus said in John 16:33:


eternal reunion! Thank you, Lord!
