Dear friends, we already have many testimonies, and it is powerful to see how God's presence touches people during prayer—often bringing them to tears.

football with them, and the other went out to evangelize. It was a wonderful experience, and at the end the teenagers thanked us and said, 'We will never forget this moment with you.' Through small acts of kindness, we had the privilege of showing these young people Jesus."

Right now, our focus is on member care, evangelism, mobilizing people for missions, praying for brothers and sisters, and serving in deliverance ministry. It is amazing to see how God is using us—with His Word and the authority He has given us! In the area of member care—accompanying and supporting missionaries—we feel strongly that God is using us to encourage, strengthen, and pray for them. It brings us great joy to be there for them!
