HEALTHY BABY

Dear friends and family,

We are thankful for a healthy, growing baby. It is an exciting season as we get ready to become parents. Kimleang is now 7 months pregnant, and her belly is getting bigger and bigger. We have prayed about where to deliver the baby and visited multiple hospitals in different cities. Our plan is to go to a private hospital in the capital, Phnom Penh. As we were planning, God provided a place for us to stay during the time while we wait. The doctors want us in Phnom Penh, about 5 hours by car from Battambang, by week 36. This means we will travel to the capital at the end of June to wait for our baby.

PRAYER & VISION TRIP TO MONDULKIRI

Our good friends are planning to start a new YWAM ministry in Mondulkiri province, close to Vietnam, about 11 hours by car from Battambang. In April, we, together with three other families, went on a one-week trip to Mondulkiri to pray, get God's heart for the province, and build relationships with local pastors and other ministries. It was such a good time seeking God's heart together. One of our highlights was the time we spent at a local pastor's house and coffee farm. He is using the farm to pay for his living expenses and support the church. His story of following God since before the Khmer Rouge was so encouraging.

BIBLE SCHOOL FINISHED

Since April, David has finished staffing his first 9-month School of Biblical Studies. He had the privilege of walking alongside internationals and Cambodians who grew in their knowledge of God and His Word, as well as in their love for God and missions. Now, most of the students are continuing their journey in missions, doing ministry in Papua New Guinea, Indonesia, Brazil, and around Cambodia.
