Luganda is one of the main languages in Uganda. I've been learning it since 2019 (!) but have only made real progress recently. This summer, I started writing „mini diaries“ in Luganda (Google Translate is a big help!). **And as of this November, I started „real“ language classes**, 2x a week on Zoom. I met the teacher in Uganda; he and his wife are missionaries and expecting their first child very soon. The classes are a good way for them to **supplement their income**. Meanwhile, another Ugandan pastor just opened a mini business with the capital I sent them: They now can be a mobile money lender, like a mini bank people use through their cellphones. Such steps are small, but they change the

lives of entire families. And I'm glad I can support people in small ways, even when I'm not back in Uganda yet.

Working at a Toy Store

At this point, I am grateful that I am successfully working at a toy store. I work 10-15h a week at the shop "ROFU Kinderland" in Bruchsal near my home.

The shifts are only 5h long, and I don't need to lift heavy things. Overall, I like the job and the team.

The only challenge is that my boss gets upset very easily. Moreover, she got very upset with me, due to a misunderstanding:

I hadn't mentioned in my job interview that I wanted to go to Uganda. I thought that 8 months of work time were a good amount, and saying something would be too far out. But when my boss realized I was leaving after less than 12 months, she yelled: „If I had known that, I'd have never hired you!“ – lack of staff, recruiting, and training people cost a lot of time and money. I could understand the frustration to some extent and apologized. For now, she seems to have calmed down, because I've been scheduled for work until at least January. I almost suspect that this woman is suffering from early stages of burnout, since emotional irritability and lack of flexibility are typical symptoms, and she is much nicer if you catch her on a less stressful day. I pray that God meets this lady and strengthens her physical and emotional health.


Even if I don't stay until summer, I'm grateful: **The job is proving to me that my health is getting better, and that I can handle working with people several hours at a time. You can pray that God gives me strength and patience to pass on his love, even to people who aren't easy to love.**

In a sense, this work is a practical continuation of the contents of my book. **The work will be funded 100% by donations – a step of faith towards God.**

Many of you know that I wrote a book: „Weltgestalter“ came out in Germany 2022. It's a “nonfiction book for non-readers“, which invites people to live all areas of life in light of heaven's perspective, from areas like personal relationships to climate change or social justice. It's a mix of stories, biblical and scientific input, and practical inspiration.

As soon as I published the German book, my English-speaking friends asked if I could publish an English version. I said no for a long time because my publisher wouldn't do it.
