We are writing this letter with an urgent concern.

<u>But first</u>, I'd like to briefly share **a few thoughts** that are currently on my heart, as well as something from this past summer:

Each of us has a birth name — one given to us by our parents at birth. But what might be the name that God gives you when you arrive at His place?

Here's a short list of **names**:

Tabitha = was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did (Acts 9:36)

Epaphras = a servant of Christ Jesus, who is always labouring fervently in prayers for you (Col. 4:12)

Aquila and Priscilla = with the church that meets in their house (1 Cor. 16:19)

Demas = has forsaken me, because he loved this present world! (2 Tim. 4:10)

Apelles = the approved one in Christ (Rom. 16:10)

These thoughts have truly made me reflect deeply.

<u>This past summer</u> was incredibly rich in every way. Our garden gave us an amazing harvest – more tomatoes than ever before, along with cucumbers, zucchini, Hokkaido, long pointed peppers, leeks, beans, and even very large kohlrabi.

Our youth camp was also richly blessed, which this time our "older teens" (ages 15–21), together with their leaders Bogdan (25) and Malina (21), organized entirely on their own. We are very happy about our lively and growing youth ministry and are sooo thankful to God for it!

We also feel **richly blessed** by our **young Albert** (19), who decided to do a voluntary social year with us on the farm. He's a committed Christian and a hardworking team member – both on the farm and in our youth and children's ministry.

And now our prayer requests:

- We are still praying about what the **next discipleship year** should look like. Together with Stefan Armer, we're considering whether this time we should focus on "**our own disciples**" meaning **leadership training for this young generation** who are so eager and willing to serve God!
- The urgent issue is "our central heating system": this old one, which I brought here 10 years ago from a dairy factory in Germany, has served us very well until now. Last week, however, I suddenly noticed that it was leaking. I was shocked, as winter is just around the corner. I asked various people for advice, but we came to the conclusion that we need a new central heating system.

After checking on the internet, we found that a new unit capable of heating our 12 guest rooms, dining room, community room, and our own wooden house would cost around **10,000 euros**.

We currently have **5,000 euros** in savings for this.
