In April we wrote that there were still obstacles retarding the construction of a water fountain for the Health Centre in Koukoum. We are excited to tell you today that the fountain is now built and operational, on the premises of the Centre but accessible for all the villagers. It was finished and inaugurated a few weeks ago. (Hebrews 10:36) Since we do indeed have received a part of the promise, we are now encouraged to persevere still: "But if we **hope** for what we do not see, we wait for it with **patience**!" Isaac and André (Samuel's brother) are monitoring and accompanying the next steps, while Samuel will continue to advise and coordinate from France during the following months.

He is now waiting for a place at university in Germany, preparing to continue his training.
