Dear friends and mission partners!

After a long break, we are delighted to be able to report back to you on the events of the last few months and the latest developments. Thank you for your loyalty and interest.

As we announced in March 2025, we are no longer involved in ministry with the church in Cholet since last September, but we still live here. We have decided that this is a sabbatical year for us, during which Sabine continues to work as a German teacher and Samuel pursues other projects. More about that below.

Taking stock ...

In May, we had the privilege of spending five days in the south of France for a time of reflection with guided debriefing. We used this time very consciously to take stock and examine our hearts regarding our ministry here in France, and we are grateful for all the input we received. Conclusion: a conviction that God still has a mission for us here, but that we will carry it out in a slightly different context.

... and looking ahead

Since the beginning of last year, we have been asking the Lord to show us where and how we should continue. Due to the fact that our boys now all live in Germany, our thoughts turned more towards the east again, and so it happened that we came into contact with another church union that has several churches in Alsace. After a thorough process of getting to know each other, during which we travelled to Alsace several times in the autumn, we recently learned that Samuel will be able to take up pastoral ministry there as part of a leadership team this summer. We are very glad and happy that the Lord is opening a door for us there and look forward to this next stage. .../...

What is currently happening ...

'Sabbath' – resting from our usual ministry activities. Giving the 'land' that we work and harvest a rest. Reorienting ourselves towards God. So far, this means that we want to remain faithful to what God called us to do when we went to France with GLOBE Mission in 2008. Our hearts beat for the church, because Jesus gave us the commission to make disciples. And our hearts beat for missions, because people need to hear and understand the gospel in order to follow Jesus – both in France and elsewhere.

For Sabine, this means, among other things, taking care of her physical health this year. In mid-December, she underwent her first knee surgery, from which she is recovering quite well, and in June she is expected to have a second surgery with the goal of being able to walk without pain again. In between, Sabine continues to work as a teacher and is very grateful for this opportunity. In the autumn, she invited pupils at her school to read the Bible together during their lunch break, and some were very interested and enjoyed coming. We hope that they will continue to come after the break due to the operation.

Samuel has the opportunity to further develop and support the 'Health Centre' project in Cameroon, and so he will be there for several months starting in January. In January, a small team from France flew there again and devoted 14 days to this ministry. This is always precious, and we are grateful for these faithful people who have been supporting the project for several years. For Samuel, it is also a good opportunity to reconnect with family in Cameroon.

... and some prayer points

- 🔔 That the Lord will continue to lead us and allow us to grow in Him, so that we may always be useful instruments in His hands.
- 🔔 That the Lord will grant us grace to bring everything here to a successful conclusion, including the practical aspects of Sabine's transfer and our housing situation.
- 🔔 That the health centre in Cameroon continues to develop and that the Lord keeps His protective hand over it, for 'unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labour in vain.'
- 🔔 That the people working at the health centre follow Jesus and that many people hear the gospel through this ministry and turn to Jesus.
- 🔔 For the church in Alsace that will appoint Samuel as a pastor, that the Lord will bless them and that they will bear much fruit for the Kingdom of God.
- 🔔 For our families in Germany and Cameroon, that they will remain faithful to Jesus, and that all those who do not yet follow Jesus will recognise him and turn to him!

We are convinced that our God reigns supreme, even though the world seems to be becoming increasingly uncertain at present, and that He is faithful to those who cling to Him, even if it comes at a cost to us. We thank you wholeheartedly for your prayers and your support in seeking wisdom and guidance.
