• VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM UPDATE •

Good things are happening!

All the Vocational Training Program trainees are now able to fabricate simple metal objects such as stools, tables, and stands. This is a significant milestone in using the skills they've developed and techniques learned! The trainees also made notable progress in practical farming and entrepreneurship training: harvesting produce, crop management practices, correct practices of giving poultry vaccines, and poultry management. Life skills training is also ongoing.
