

83 High School students attended the 4-day workshop (56 Challenge Farm students, 27 related to our staff)! During the 4 days, guest speakers and staff covered many topics: discipline to achieve success, relationships and success, forgiveness and attitude, mental wellness, godliness and contentment, and more. The teens were encouraged; and in separate small groups of boys and girls, discussed sexuality, and any challenges they were facing as high schoolers. There were also times for counseling and one-on-one mentoring, prayer, worship, and self-reflection. 26 souls came to the Lord! The students also enjoyed free time playing games. We hope to make the mini-conference an annual event.
