There are no shortcuts in our village! It's notable what the staff do to serve the children! The cooks prepare all the children's meals over wood fires ~ 3 meals a day! Maintenance staff trims and cuts the grass with wooden-handled slashers. Greenhouses and vegetable gardens are weeded, cows are milked, our farm is tilled, and all the wood we use for cooking is chopped by hand. Even the kids wash their clothes, bedding, and towels by hand! Most of the staff walk to and from our village, or commute on a motorbike, bicycle, or by Boda boda.

Christine, our seamstress, has been serving the children for 15 years, spending most of her days sewing. Except for buttonholes and reinforcing stitching, **she uses a manual sewing machine to make all the boys' and girls' school uniforms**, boys' play shorts, and repair torn clothes. All this is done without paper patterns. After taking a child's measurements, she cuts the uniform pieces directly from the fabric and then starts stitching! Counting just the uniforms alone, she makes about 150 of them a year. Christine has made about **2,250 uniforms** to date! When she's not sewing, she helps with cooking.


