THE GAMES CHILDREN PLAY

Games bring laughter! Playtime is part of the healing and rehabilitation process. The kids play on sliding boards, seesaws, swings, and a sandbox for the little ones, and they play checkers, cards, and Scrabble. They also enjoy some special games!



Chapata: girls hop on one foot and with the other push a stone or small broken tile through each square. The winner is the first one to go through all the squares without touching the lines!



Relay race using old wire to drive bucket lids, first to reach the finish line without the lid falling wins.



Uzi (yarn game): Two girls hold yarn at knee height while others jump in and out of the yarn.



Kalongolongo: playing house, cooking meals using empty containers, utensils, mud and grass.


