
"On 19th April 2023 at around 4:30pm, Social work Department received a call from the Children's Department office in Kitale to go and pick up two children who had been rescued from a case of assault by their parent...

Upon arrival at the Children's Department, the children looked in need of proper care and protection. They had fresh wounds all over their bodies that were terrifying to look at. The wounds had been inflicted by their own biological father. The little girl, around the age of 6, had a burn wound on her leg. The children were also malnourished, traumatized, and needed every care that could be given to them.

They were admitted to Challenge Farm where they will be assured of holistic provision for their basic needs, and healing for their tender souls. It hurts to see the state of these children when they arrived at the Farm. Indeed, we have received many cases, but this case was traumatizing to see. The world can be cruel, but I believe this shouldn't be extended to young tender souls. Please pray with us for this mission. God is our healer." – *Magdalyne*






PRAYER NEEDS FROM THE KIDS






